- Upon arrival, please stop at the resort entrance stop sign and report to the office. Site assignment and your check in paperwork will be placed outside the doors of the registration office on the Bulletin Board.

If you have arrived at Crystal Springs Resort and Do Not have a Reservation, please phone our office to register. You can park in an available site marked yellow on the site map. Wave us down on the golf cart if you see us. We may be away from the office but will contact you regarding your registration and stay when we return to the office.

- At this time our Store, Washrooms and Laundry room are closed. All campers must be self-contained.

As we all deal with the COVID-19 pandemic, we want to assure you that we are following all directives from the Public Health Authority. We believe that we offer an opportunity to utilize our facilities to self-isolate and to keep distance from others, social distancing.

We encourage you to follow recommendations as provided by provincial health authorities, to reduce the likelihood of catching or spreading the virus, which include:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds;
